

Official Rules and Regulations of WSSRA's Wacky Quacky Duck Splash

1. Ducks will be sent down the waterslides at the Park District of Forest Park Aquatic Center during the WSSRA Splish Splash Summer Bash event: Wednesday, July 19, 2023. Event time is 6:30pm – 9:00pm.
2. The number of race heats will be determined by the total number of qualified entries.
3. A final race heat for the grand prize will be held at approximately 8:45pm on Wednesday, July 19, 2023.
4. **All ducks entered will be provided by WSSRA and shall remain the property of WSSRA.**
5. Once the ducks are launched, they are on their own. Attempts to free a duck will only be permitted by WSSRA authorized representatives.
6. A number will be assigned to each duck relating to the number on the duck entry form. Multiple ducks will be assigned separate duck numbers. A list of winner's names and corresponding duck numbers can be obtained from WSSRA by sending a written request including a self-addressed stamped envelope to: WSSRA Wacky Quacky Duck Splash, 2915 Maple Street, Franklin Park, IL 60131.
7. The entry form must be completely filled out and delivered to WSSRA or an authorized representative of WSSRA or received by mail by July 14, 2023, at the address set forth in paragraph four (4). Entries received on "Race Day" Wednesday, July 19, 2023, need to be received by WSSRA at Duck Central Registration in the Park District of Forest Park Aquatic Center 15 minutes before the start of the race, for an entry to be eligible win any prize. Entrants assume the risk of non-delivery of any entries to WSSRA or an authorized representative of the WSSRA.
8. **Race winners need not be present to win.**
9. Race judges are not eligible to win.
10. No cash equivalent prizes will be provided in lieu of the designated prizes. Any and all taxes and similar fees are the sole responsibility of the winner.
11. Duck Race entrants release WSSRA and its officers, directors and staff and other related entities from any and all liability with respect to prizes.
12. By entering, winners consent to the promotional use of their names and likenesses without additional compensation.
13. Chances of winning depend on the total number of qualified entries.
14. This event is subject to all federal, state, and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited by law.
15. All decisions and interpretations of rules and regulations will be made by WSSRA and its judgment is final.
16. If WSSRA determines in its sole discretion that the race cannot occur at the scheduled time for any reason, the WSSRA can postpone the race to another date and time by public announcement thereof.
